Body Watching: Gender, Power, and Nonverbal Communication

Dr. Janet Mills is a body watcher...but lest you think this an unseemly pastime for the retired Boise State professor, be assured: she does it for professional reasons. And she watches women as well as men in the mixed-sex workplace. Mills describes and demonstrates how men and women speak different body language. Using the audience as a database and as volunteers, she gently and humorously illustrates how gendered behaviors convey unspoken messages of power, dominance, and high status...or affiliation, subordination, and low status. The potentials for confusion and misrepresentation are clear. So are implications for increased effectiveness of leaders.
