County Assessor: Roles & Responsibilities

- Assess & Reappraisal of Property Values
- Title & license motor vehicles, mobile homes & other vessels
- Upon direction from Governor: register county militia members



Assessment of Property

REAL PROPERTY

- residential, including manufactured homes
- Improved/Unimproved Land
- Commercial/Industrial
- Agricultural Land
- Forest Land

PERSONAL PROPERTY

- If it's not real...it's personal (§63-601)
- Is it exempt?
 - Household goods, Intangible, Business Inventory
 - Transient
 - Less than \$250,000



Other Duties Related to Market Value & Taxes

- Mapping
 - Deed processing
 - Platting
- Valuation Appeals (Article VII, Sec. 5, Idaho Constitution)
- Processing property tax exemption applications
- Property Tax Reduction/Deferral & 100%
 Service-Connected Disabled Veteran Benefit



DMV: Vehicle Registration & Titles





County Assessor & BOCC

- Fixes salaries for County Assessor position (§31-816)
- Required to furnish necessary funds and personnel to carry out county valuation program (§63-314)
 - County revaluation levy (may not exceed 0.04%)
- Board of Equalization (§63-3501 & 63-503(1))



County Assessor & Other County Offices

- County Clerk
- County Treasurer
- County Sheriff
- County Prosecutor



Possible Misconceptions about the Office



- Assessors raise values because taxing districts want more money
- Assessors set property taxes
- My property should not be valued for more than I paid for it
- My value/taxes cannot increase more than 3% per year
- If my value goes up then my property taxes automatically go up



Clerk of the District Court





County Recorder

- Custody of and must keep all books, records, maps, and papers deposited in their office
- Records records required by state law
 - Marriage certificates
 - Deeds
 - Wills admitted to probate
 - Death certificates
 - And more...





County Elections Officer





County Ex Officio Auditor

- County auditor serves as county budget officer
- Compiles and prepare preliminary budget
- Ensures compliance with approved budget
- Submits quarterly statements to BOCC showing expenditures and liabilities against each separate budget as well as unexpended and unencumbered balances of each budget
 - Info allows BOCC to take action to prevent deficits or excessive expenditures from appropriations provided in county budget



County Clerk & Board of County Commissioners

- BOCC fixes salary of county clerk position each year
- Clerk empowered to appoint deputies and assistants needed to carry out duties of office
- Compensation of clerk's staff determined by county budget approved by county commissioners
- As clerk of BOCC, county clerk may assign this duty to a staff member



County Clerk & Other County Offices

Many of the interactions the clerk has with other county officials were covered when discussing their five distinct roles, but here are a few more.

- All county elected officials & department heads
- County Treasurer
- County Assessor
- County Prosecutor



Possible Misconceptions about the Office



- 99% of what I do is elections
- Court clerks are the "Judge's" employees
- Clerks can do what they want vs. upholding the law and statutes
- Clerks control local government finances



Board of County Commissioners




Board of County Commissioners: Roles & Responsibilities

Acts as all 3 branches of government at different times:

- Manager & Administrator
- Legislative Branch
- Quasi Judicial Branch



Possible Misconceptions about the Office



- In charge of other county elected officials
- Can raise taxes at will
- Have control over other local taxing districts
- Do not need to work with state or federal governments
- Make p & z decisions based on their gut
- Only manage infrastructure & roads



COUNTY CORONER



County Coroner: Roles & Responsibilities (Chapter 28, Title 31)

- Determining cause of death
- Disposition of the deceased
- Marshaling assets
- Acting sheriff authority
- Vacancies
- Continuing education requirements



County Coroner: Roles & Responsibilities (Chapter 43, Title 19)

- Investigates deaths in certain cases
- If death unattended by physician and cause of death indeterminate investigation must be referred to sheriff or chief of police
 - Jurisdiction based on where death occured, not where incident occurred
- Death reporting,
- Determine necessity of autopsies,
- Release of the body, and reporting requirements.



Next of Kin Notification

- Next of Kin Database maintained by ITD DMV
- Disclosure required to Coroner & Sheriff to report death, injury or other emergency situation involving individual





County Coroners & Other County Offices

- County Sheriff (or Police Chief depending on jurisdiction)
- Public Administrator (County Treasurer)
- County Clerk: Clerk of the District Court/ County Budget Officer
- County Prosecutor
- Board of County Commissioners



Possible Misconceptions about the Office

- Coroner just comes to collect the body
- County coroners perform autopsies
- Every death falls within the coroner's jurisdiction
- The coroner distributes death certificates





County Prosecuting Attorney




Prosecutor: Roles & Responsibilities

- Co-chief law enforcement officer
- Chief legal advisor to county
- Prosecution of all major crimes for all jurisdictions
 - Prosecution of misdemeanors for counties, cities, and the state
- Represents & defends county in civil actions

- Acts as legal advisor to other county officials performing tasks in their official capacity (ex. Public administration)
- Represents the State in child protection and mental incapacity cases

Possible Misconceptions about the Office



- Cannot give legal advice to private parties
- The office does NOT supervise other elected officials including BOCC
- The office may provide legal advice and "guidance" but each elected official acts for themselves
- Prosecutors do not pronounce sentences in criminal cases, judges do



COUNTY SHERIFF



County Sheriff: Roles & Responsibilities





Duties of the Sheriff

- Preserving the Peace
- Arrests
- Preventing riots,
 insurrections,
 breaches of peace
 Attend all courts



Search and Rescue (31-2229)

- Responsible for command
- Prepare & keep "plan to command" search and rescue capabilities and resources available
- Coordinates with other agencies when needed
- Exceptions





Enforcing Penal Laws (31-2227)

- Sheriff & Prosecutor have primary duties to enforce all penal provisions
- If deemed necessary, authorized to call for assistance from local officers within the county
- Can ask for help from ISP If advice and/or assistance is needed

- BOCC
- County Assessor
- County Clerk
- County Coroner
- County Prosecuting Attorney
- County Treasurer



Possible Misconceptions of the Office



- Handle any civil dispute
- Have authority over cities or elected officials
- Enforce federal laws
- Unrealistic expectations on police performance
- Qualified Immunity equals: Get out of Jail Free Card
- Can pick and choose which laws to enforce


County Treasurer: Roles & Responsibilities

- County Finance Officer <u>Title 31, Chapter 21</u>
- County Investment Officer <u>Title 57, Chapter 1</u>, <u>§67-1210</u> & <u>§67-1210A</u>





County Treasurer: Roles & Responsibilities



- Tax Collector §31-2102
 - Calculates, bills, and collects
 property taxes, solid waste fees,
 and special assessments levied
 by taxing districts
- Ex Officio Public Administrator§31-2102
 - Acts as personal rep for intestate estates

Treasurers & Other County Offices

- Assessor
- BOCC
- Clerk
- Coroner
- Prosecutor
- Sheriff



Possible Misconceptions of the Office



- Distinction between roles of county elected officials
- All the money received from collecting counties goes to the county
- The IRS, STC, and county treasurer are all the same
- The tax collector can change the due date for tax payments
