## **Other Business**

- Property taxes  
A committee to review property taxes has been put together. The committee has been tasked with addressing rising property taxes, exploring tax relief, encouraging economic development, and ensuring local governments have sufficient revenues to provide services.
- Medicaid Expansion  
The governor stated the state should pay for the first year but the interim committee's plan right now is to use offsets at the state level, then use counties. They would like to see up to \$10M diverted from counties. Staff will be advocating for the state to pay for the first full year and then will explore what the savings to counties truly was. The committee is also discussing combining levies to help cover additional costs.
