- Insufficient clearance

- ■Snow loads









What are we doing to help with risk?


In 2019 introduced robust Risk Management Program








Distracted
Driving

At any given time during the day, nearly 1 out of 10 drivers is using a cell phone

- "Infotainment" systems
- Inattention (backing)
- Mind wandering
- Cell phone use







Slips and Falls

- The average cost of a slip and fall is \$30,000-\$40,000 according to the CDC.
- Snow-related slips are between \$33,000-\$48,000 on average.
- Two slip/fall claims totaling nearly \$150k (1 ankle / 1 wrist fracture)



Risk Mitigation for General Liability

- Inspect
- Remove hazards
- Snow removal plan?
- Maintenance
- Lighting

Failure to do so is "negligence"
