2:30 pm Call to Order | Chair Phil McGrane

- Welcome and Introductions
- Approval of February 2021 Meeting Minutes Doug Zenner moved to approve.
   Don Hall seconded. Motion passes.
- 2:35 pm Preview 2022 Legislative Session | Bobbi-Jo Mueleman, Deputy Chief of Staff & Director of Intergovernmental Affairs, Governor's Office

Bobbi-Jo Mueleman shared the surplus will be about 1.5 billion dollars. The surplus package will include more one time investments including a big investment in education. Transportation will be another big investment proposed by the Governor. They want this to focus on maintenance of bridges. Want to know how they can partner with counties. Affordable housing is also a focus. They're looking at how they can actually help at the state level. They are looking at providing gap financing with Idaho Housing and Finance. They're working with the realtors on this issue as well. Career technical and broadband will also be a focus for more one-time dollars. The Governor will propose another tax cut. There's talk about another income tax rebate and also property taxes. Legislators have a lot of ideas about how to give property tax relief. Governor will recommend more staff to help with implementing hig projects.

For ARPA the dollars have to go through the legislature. There is some consensus with House and Senate leadership to put money towards clean water and waste water systems. Using the ARPA dollars for dams may be on the table. Broadband is also a possibility for more ARPA dollars. There looking at state/local match component to help make the local dollars go farther.

Governor has heard a lot of property tax proposals, he has committed to none.

- IG-01 Work Force Housing Valley County Commissioner Shari Maupin presented the resolution. Joe Larson made a motion for a statement of support to work on affordable or workplace housing. Linda Jones seconded. Motion carried.
- IG-02 Court Fee Remittance Power County Clerk Sharee Sprague presented the resolution proposing change of court fee remittance date from the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month to the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. Donna Peterson pointed out that the current statute is not accurate. The Treasurer does not handle this remittance fee (as is currently written in code), the auditor does. Henrianne moved to change Chapter 32 Title 31-01a to strike the word county treasurer and to change the remittance date to the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. Lon Colton seconded. Motion carried.
- IG-03 Investment Options Donna Peterson presented the Investment Option resolution that would allow treasurers to purchase CD's from out of state if that is where they can make the best return on the investment. Donna Peterson moved to approve IG-03. Brian Stender seconded. Motion carried.
- IG-04 Vape Tax Don Hall moved to approve IG-04. Donna Peterson seconded the motion. After discussion, Terrel Tovey moved to call the question. The motion to approve IG-04 approved.
- IG-05 Property Tax Relief Fund Act Terrel Tovey presented the resolution. To mitigate
  property taxes you have exemptions, revenue stream (for counties property taxes), budgets.
  Want to tax transient commodities. The funds would be used to directly buy down the
  property tax. Terrel Tovey moved to approve IG-05 as presented. Brent Mendenhall
  seconded. Motion carried.

## 4:30 pm Open Discussion | Chair Phil McGrane

Bob McQuade shared that years ago, IGA created a sub-committee to create a Board of Equalization manual. Bob suggested that IGA reconstitute a new subcommittee to take another look at the BOE manual. An assessor, commissioner, legal council would all be on the committee. Terrel Tovey suggested this idea be referred back to the IAC staff to find a structure to move forward. Chair McGrane agreed to work with IAC to determine the make-up of the sub-committee on this topic.
