The breakfast meeting was called to order by District II Chairman Denis Duman. Attendees introduced themselves to the group as a means of welcoming those who had not previously attended a District meeting.

Kathy Ackerman gave a short ethics presentation about 'white lies' and how that seemingly harmless practice can lead to other, more consequential, ethical failures.

Duman lead a discussion regarding the location and frequency of future district meetings.

Guest Senator Dan Johnson gave an update on redistricting and fielded questions regarding PILT, the State budget surplus, property tax relief and regional justice systems.

Ackerman requested that we revisit the discussion regarding District II meetings. Seth advised that meeting in the district is important in order to attract attendees who may not attend conferences. Seth also advised that meeting with legislators locally in November or December allows for discussion heading into the legislative session. Duman advises that we will look at our bylaws and make consideration of moving to three meetings per year with the ability to call for additional meetings as needed.

Dan Anderson is asking Assessors to keep track of numbers regarding homeowner's exemptions as some counties are pro-rating the exemption and some are not-discussion regarding the need for consistency and possible legislation to address this. Anderson advises that Idaho Forest Group has filed BOE appeals in both Idaho and Nez Perce Counties.

Ackerman advises that there are a few corrections needed to the minutes of the previous meeting. She will contact Shelley so they can be corrected and approved the next time we meet.

Greg Johnson moved to approve the financial report. BJ Swanson seconded the motion. Motion carried with all in favor.
