Other Business

Property tax: Senator Anthon is working on the circuit breaker program to remove the cap and reinstate the index. Rep. Skaug is working on increasing the homeowner's exemption. Realtors are concerned for a time when the homeowner's exemption could go down and they don't want that to happen. IAC staff has not heard conversations about further capping local budgets.

Public defense: IAC staff had their first meeting with the workgroup. The group is looking to build an Idaho model that works for the state. Parts of the discussion were productive and there is a path forward. The homework coming out of the meeting is to work on the organizational chart. The Governor would like to see a top down with a chief public defender but doesn't have a strong opinion on how the delivery model looks. The public defenders would like to have strong public defender oversight and less state oversight. There was consensus on rules and standards. Moving forward there isn't a need for the PDC and will work to codify rules like the ABA. This group will meet again next month.

EMS: There is a taskforce working on EMS issues. We have a handful of commissioners working on the taskforce. The goal is to create a sustainable model for EMS working in the areas of personnel, coverage, and governance. They are also working on funding. Governance is working on who should be responsible for providing the service. Personnel is working on recruitment and retention. Coverage is working on how to make sure there is proper access to services across the state.

Nez Perce County Commissioner Doug Zenner made a motion to adjourn, Valley County Commissioner Sherry Maupin seconded. Motion carried.
