I. Call to Order

President Bourn called the meeting to order at 10:02 am on Friday, February 12, 2021.

II. HB0031

President Bourn thanked Owens and Brassfield for killing HB0031. It doesn't look like this will come back any time soon. Brassfield noted that the coroners really showed up to talk about why they opposed it and thanked them for their help.

III. PTSD Legislation

Owens has been working on adding coroners to the PTSD statute that was enacted in 2019. She's not sure if we can get it through this year but if we can introduce it this year maybe we can get it passed next year in the 2022 session. Owens thought that Lorna Jorgenson might be able to help draft the legislation if she gives her the talking points.

Keene moved to move forward with adding coroners to the PTSD bill this session, Ernest second. Motion passed unanimously.
