I. Call to Order

Bourn called the meeting to order at 7:00 am on Thursday, February 6, 2020.

II. 2020 IAC&ME Symposium Update

The group discussed how many coroners and deputies to send to Las Vegas (or other training with permission). Cundiff noted that there are a few expenses it would be good to clarify if the association will pay for. IAC staff see that the room rates are all over the place for the Golden Nugget.
