### MEETING AGENDA

*Chair Jeff Hough called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.*

Chair Hough welcomed the committee members, introduced Idaho's new Secretary of State, Phil McGrane, and invited him to take a few minutes to address the committee. Secretary McGrane shared that he has a cohesive team and acknowledged that there is much to learn as a new SOS with the legislature in town simultaneously.

*Nez Perce County Commissioner Doug Zenner made a motion to approve. Lincoln County Assessor Linda Jones seconded. Motion carried.*

Bobbi-Jo Mueleman gave an update on the Governor's priorities, including education, \$120 M in property tax relief, and transportation priorities that include a new competitive grant program run through ITD with 50% to urban and 50% to rural to help with projects that don't qualify under other programs and would not otherwise be completed. Members of the committee asked questions about property taxes, workforce housing, EMS, and more.

Don Hall gave a quick update on the priorities and policies set by the legislative committee.

Sara Westbrook gave an update on House Bill 0022, which would withhold sales tax from local governments if they fail to meet specific parameters.

Westbrook also mentioned Senate Bill 1025 regarding marriage licenses and SJR101, an Initiative that alters the qualifications regarding signature requirements from 6 percent in 18 legislative districts to 6 percent in all 35 districts.

Seth Grigg shared that Rep. Blanksma proposed legislation last year to create a uniform assessment notice that would include two previous years of property taxes.

A bill that may be introduced would require the county treasurer to remit late penalties and interest to the taxing districts. The treasurers plan to discuss this at their meeting later in the week. There was a diversity of opinions regarding the issue earlier in the week.

Sara Westbrook gave an update on the EMS Sustainability Taskforce.

Seth Grigg fielded questions from the committee regarding the proposals currently being floated by the House and Senate. He explained that all property tax relief ideas are still on the table.

The committee adjourned at 3:30 p.m.
