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Who is CES?

- CES is a member-owned governmental purchasing cooperative founded in 1979 in Albuquerque, NM, serving over 600+ agencies in NM and the US, that allows public agencies to purchase products and services through existing contracts, saving them time and money.
- CES serves Public Education, State + Local Gov't, Special Subdivisions of Gov't, Native American / Tribal Gov't.



Who is CES? ...continued

- CES offers approximately 800+ contracts in over 100 categories and subcategories ready for CES members' use.
- The Idaho Procurement Code 67-2807 ("Cooperative Purchasing") and 67-9224 (Cooperative and group discount purchasing"), provide the general framework for public agencies in Idaho to use cooperative agreements such as CES'.
- CES' contracts are also in compliance with 2CFR Part 200, including requirements under "EDGAR" (the Education Department General Administrative Regulations) as well as FEMA and Homeland Security requirements.



What Does CES Do? - Cooperative Purchasing

- CES was formed with the intention to be an extension of Members' procurement departments so they can do more with existing resources without augmenting staff.
- CES leverages the purchasing power of many member agencies which translates to best obtainable pricing and more favorable terms for CES members.



What Does CES Do? - Cooperative Purchasing ... continued

- CES issues and manages its own solicitations and supplier relations, negotiates and awards its own contracts, no external 3rd-party lead agency handles the procurement process for CES and its members.
- CES' solicitation method is Request for Proposal because
 - 1) it vets vendors based on qualifications, and
 - 2) can make multiple awards for sufficient coverage statewide.

CES – Public Sector Construction Program

- CES provides innovative procurement solutions in public sector construction such as Job Order Contracting and Infrastructure as a Service (coming FY 2026-2027).
- CES solicits throughout ID to contract with local contractors, in effect, creating and promoting economic development in your area.
- Generally, 95%+ local contractor + vendor participation while saving months in procurement time and hundreds of thousands in contracting and construction costs.

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How Can CES Help Me and My Agency?

- Saves procurement departments time and money in developing, issuing, evaluating, and awarding solicitations. 3 – 4 mos. for non-construction, 4 – 8 mos. for construction RFPs.
- There are no fees to be a CES member or for the use of its contracts.
- CES charges a 2% CAF (Vendor pays) where E&I charges over 4%, OMNIA, Sourcewell, BuyBoard charge 3%, so it costs more to ID taxpayers when external, non-IAC vetted cooperative contracts are used than by using a CES contract.



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How Can CES Help Me and My Agency? ... cont.

- Cost savings range between 5% - 60%. Heavy equipment 20+%, vehicles 5% - 15%, fire, brush trucks 2%, technology up to 50%, office supplies 40%.
- *Leasing options available.
- 800+ contracts with 500+ vendors ready for use. National contracts such as Amazon Business, Apple, AT&T, Staples, Hellas, AstroTurf, John Deere, etc.



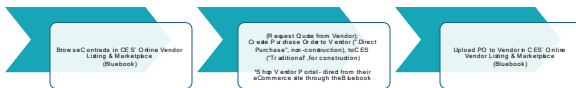
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How Can CES Help Me and My Agency? ... cont.

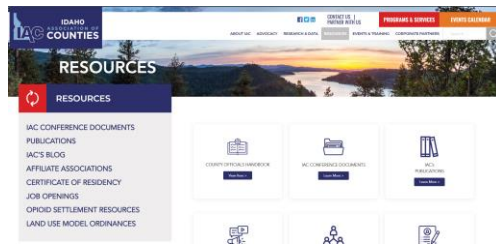

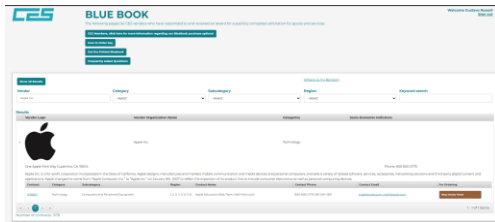
CES – 3 Step Purchasing Process



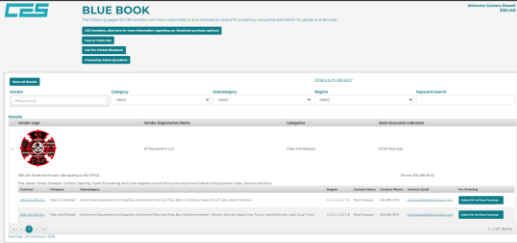

CES – Amazon Business Program (solicited by CES)

- The very first step is to email: ces-contract@amazon.com to either create an account or enhance your existing account, retain the credits you have earned, etc., by leveraging the CES-Amazon Business contract.
- Amazon Business will keep track of your accrued credits and issue your agency a check as usual. CES will incorporate your agency's spending with Amazon Business into your total spend through CES contracts, allowing your agency to earn additional credits from CES.

IaaS (Infrastructure as a Service)

Project Development

- Site visit to develop the general scope of work
- Vendor Selection**
 - Provide list of qualified vendors based on the scope of work
 - Assist in "Mini-Bid process"

Detailed Cost Proposal Development & Review

- Joint scope meeting with vendor on site. Scope of work and compliance

Document Submission

- CES uploads all required documents

Construction Administration

- Perform administrative functions as an "Owner Representative"

PaaS Program (Procurement as a Service)

Procurement Development

- Determine the appropriate procurement vehicle (ITB or RFP)
- Define the project description, funding source/s, budget and timeline

ITB or RFP Development

- Provide ITB or RFP documents specific to the member needs following all state and Public Works statutes and the NMJ procurement code
- Direct involvement in the solicitation process from legal advertisement to Notice of Award and execution of contracts



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Open-Ended RFP

- CES' RFPs terms and conditions have language that allows, at the request of an Idaho public agency, for the acceptance of an RFP proposal for CES' review and evaluation, from a vendor that the agency needs to use to procure products or services.
- For transparency and open and fair competition, CES will evaluate the proposal using the same criteria used at the time of the original RFP event.
- If the vendor (Offeror) obtains a number of points meeting or exceeding the minimal threshold for award (75% of the highest score), per the original RFP's tabulation, that vendor will receive a recommendation for award.

What to Expect Next

- Beginning Oct. 1, 2025, IAC + CES will make contracts available to IAC 44 member counties.
- CES ID Regional Managers will begin contacting your agency to onboard you as a member so you can start using CES' products & services.
- RFPs for construction and A/E will be issued in February 2025. *Let your CES ID Regional Manager know what local contractors you would like for CES to contact to submit a proposal and compete for a contract that you can use.



Local Support for IAC Agencies

- Your IAC team has been working with CES to bring to your agencies a myriad of contracts that you can use.
- CES & IAC have collaborated in hiring 2 Regional Managers to support Idaho's 44 counties with ready-to-use contracts, technical assistance, trainings, and workshops.
- Available to IAC Members for consultation, CES will have Construction Analysts with vast experience in public sector construction.
- In 2026 - 2027, CES will also launch *Procurement as a Service* (PaaS) and *Infrastructure as a Service* (IaaS) designed to help agencies with their procurement needs while maximizing existing resources without having to augment staff.
