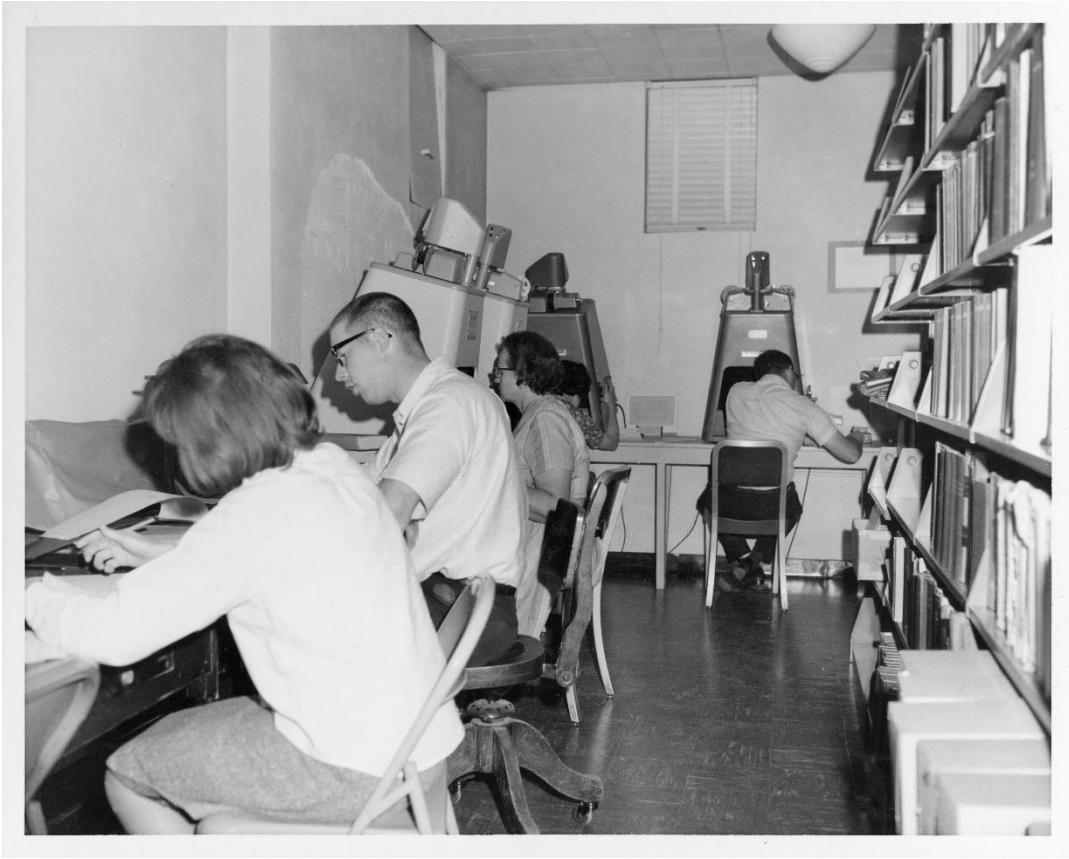

P1966-102-15. Patrons Using Microfilm. Idaho State Archives.

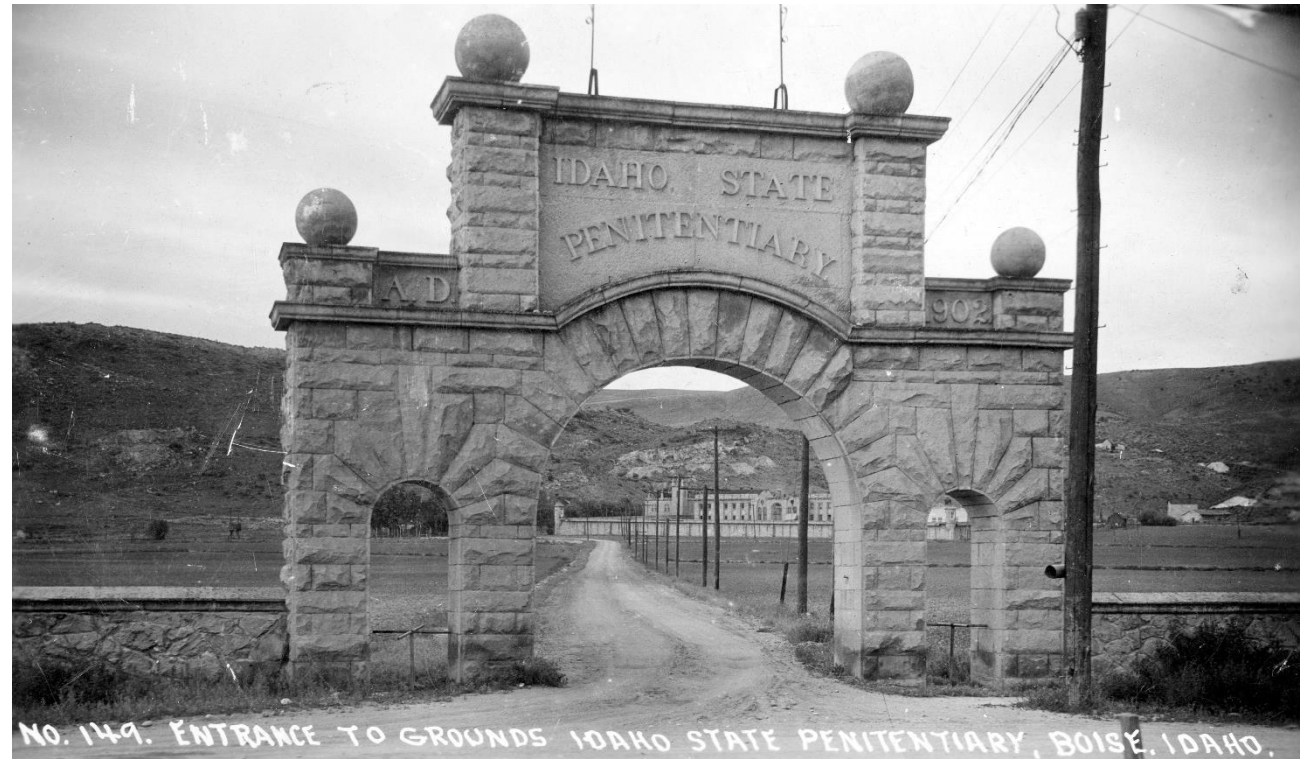

NO. 149. ENTRANCE TO GROUNDS IDAHO STATE PENITENTIARY, BOISE, IDAHO.

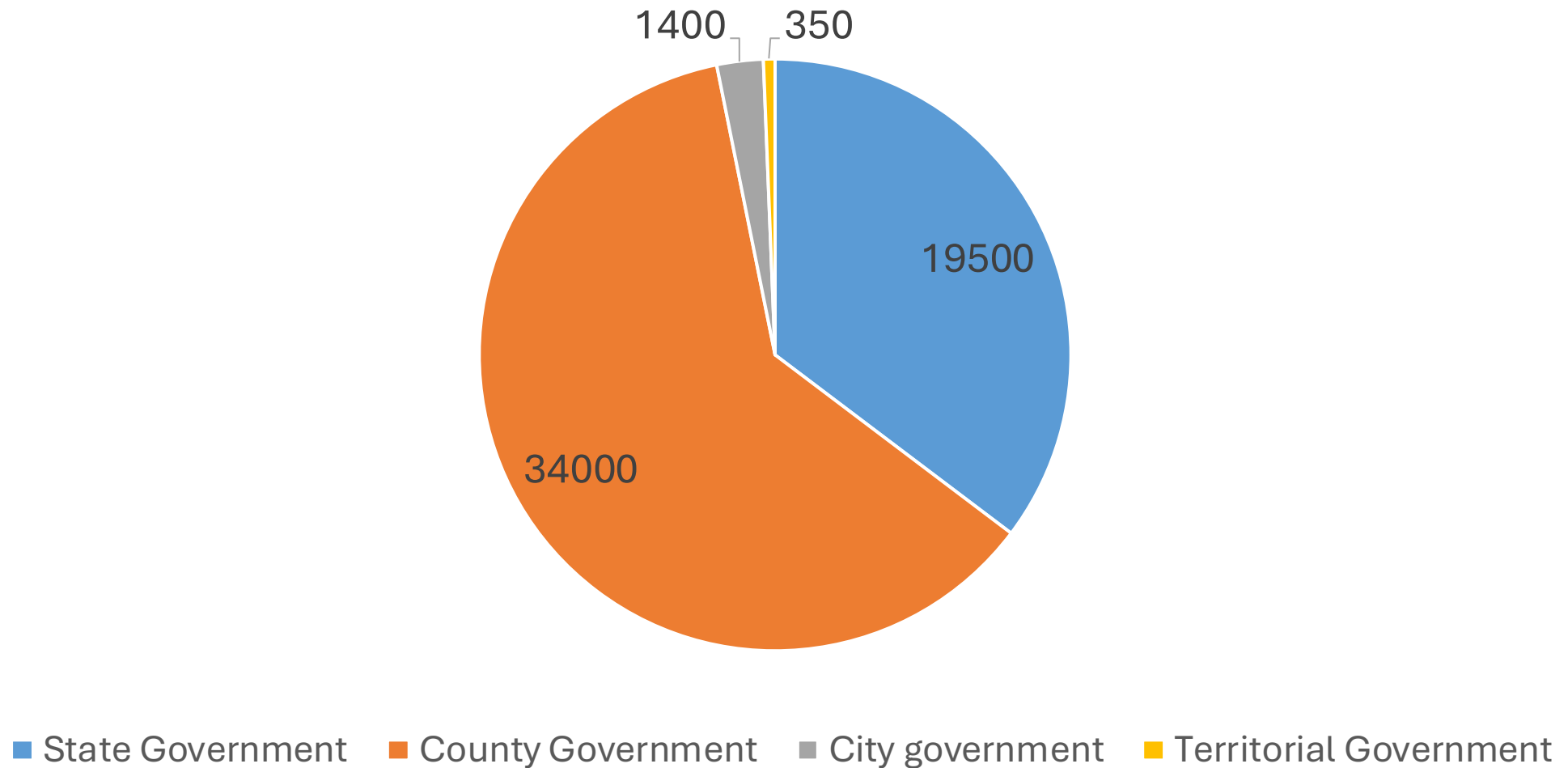

Collections

- Government Records: 55,250 cubic feet
 - Photographs: 1,000,000+ items
 - Manuscript (donated) Records: 6,000 cubic feet
 - Oral Histories: 3,000 interviews
 - Microfilm: historic newspapers county and federal records
 - Digital Newspapers: ChroniclingAmerica.loc.gov
 - Books: 34,500
 - Maps: 3,000

ISA's Government Records Holdings in cubic feet



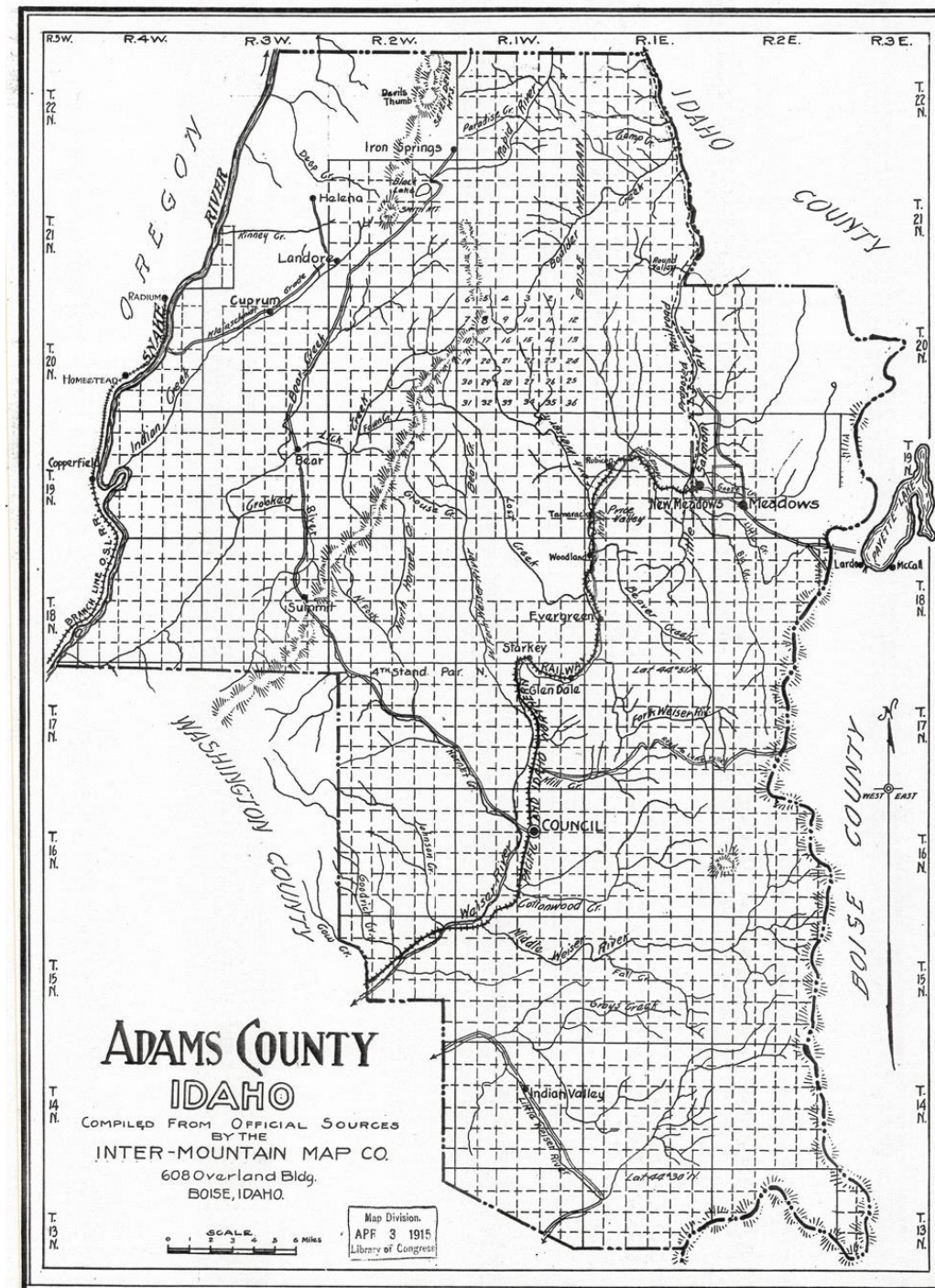
ISA collects records that:

- Are Permanent
- Are open to the public
- Are no longer active
- Demonstrate Fiscal, Administrative, Legal, and/or Long-term historic value (FALL)

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County Records

- Court Records
- Commissioners' Minutes
- Ordinances
- Resolutions
- Financial Reports
- Assessors
- Deed Books
- School Districts
- Coroners
- Parks and Recreation
- Mining Districts
- Highway Districts
- Plat Books/Maps
- Treasurers

Court Records

- Permanent historic probate, 50+ years old
- District Court Registers
- Cases successfully appealed to Supreme Court
- Significant to local communities
- Receive significant media coverage, notoriety, or controversy



What ISA offers

- Free storage
- Intellectual control
- Preservation
- Security
- Access



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What ISA offers

- Shift responsibility for public records requests from county staff to ISA staff
- Storage for physical copies after completion of digitization projects
- Consulting on digitization and physical preservation



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Current Projects: RECA

- 3,500 Claims Assisted
- Help people prove Idaho residency from 1951-1962
- Provide access to birth (1907-1911), marriage, and divorce records



Current Projects – Idaho Digital Archive



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State Records Center – different from Archives



- Stores records not open to the public
- Stores active records
- Stores records still under retention
- Fee-based service (cost-recovery only)

Future Projects – Digital State Records Center

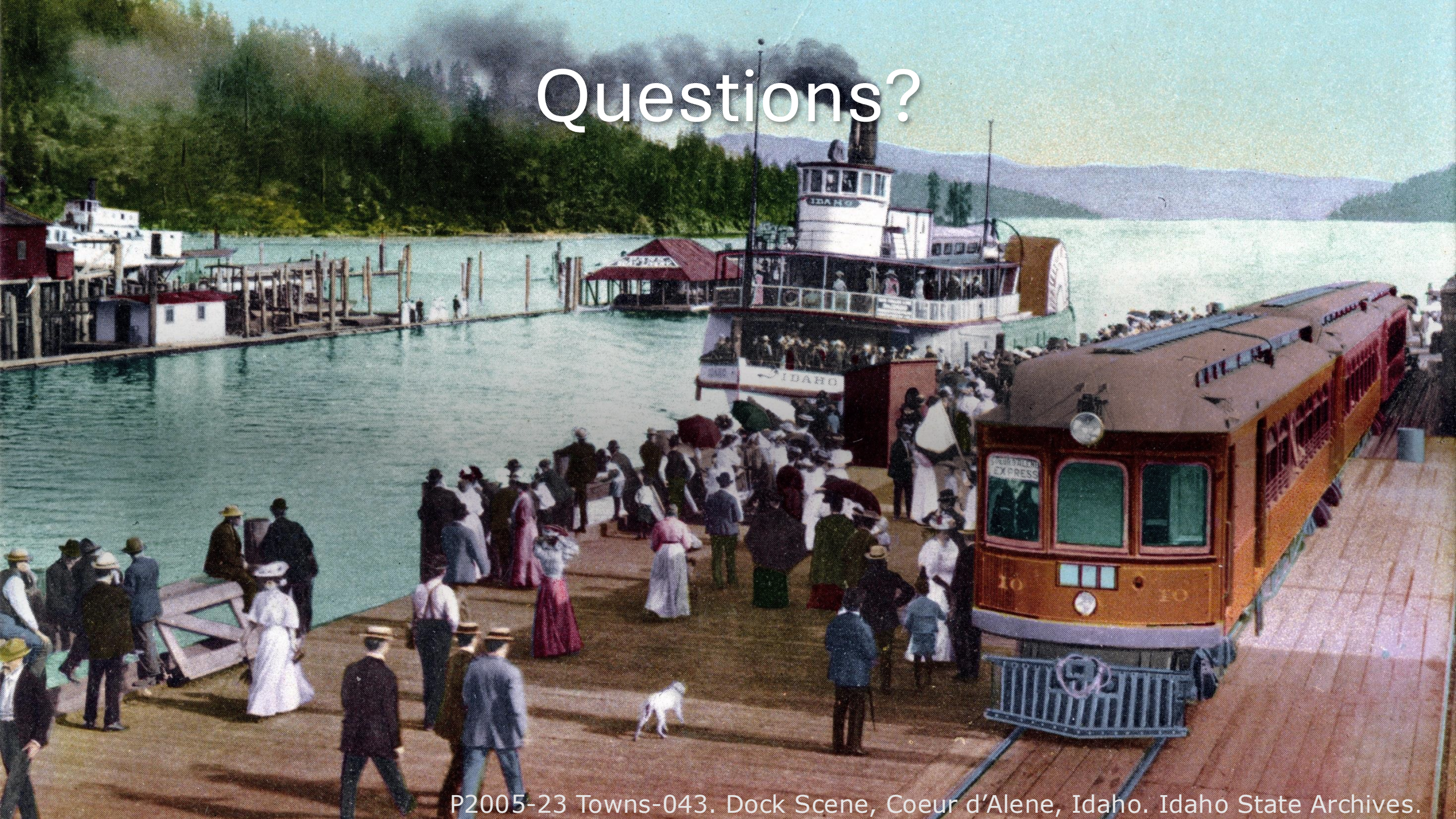
The Digital State Records Center will be like an extension of your network storage for:
